Champagne & Sparkling Wine

1. Louis Dornier et Fils Brut – *France*

£40.00 Bottle

A light, fresh, vigorously youthful champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse & long, crisp palate.

2. Taittinger Brut Réserve – *France*

£60.00 Bottle

The intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity & superb elegance is due to a predominance of Chardonnay in the blend.

3. Champagne Jacquart Blanc De Blanc – *France*

£65.00 Bottle

Shows notes of fresh pear, fig & almond, with hints of orange blossom and richer notes of honey & baked bread.

4. Galanti Prosecco Extra Dry – *Italy*

£7.25 125ml Glass, £29.00 Bottle

Light & lively, with ripe pears & lemons rounded off with hint of sweetness.

5. Bottega Gold Prosecco Brut – *Italy*

£40 Bottle

Characteristic, fruity with scents of golden apple, Williams pear, acacia flowers & lily of the valley.

6. Bottega Rose Gold – *Italy*

£40 Bottle

Notes of mixed red berries alongside floral & white fruit aromas.

7. Cordonú Brut, Cava – *Spain*

£30.00 Bottle

Refreshing Cava with delicious floral aromas & a dry finish.

8. Pigalle Brut – *Spain*

£6.50 125ml Glass, £22 Bottle

Characteristic, fruity with scents of golden apple, Williams pear, acacia flowers & lily of the valley.

9. Pigalle Rosé Sec – *Spain*

Glass, £22 Bottle

Coral-coloured sparkling rosé with ripe, summer fruit flavours sprinkled with sugar.

10. Gancia Asti – *Italy*

£25 Bottle

Gancia Asti is a sweet sparkling wine with a bright fresh taste of the Moscato Bianco grapes.

White Wine

11.Los Romeros Sauvignon Blanc – *Chile*

£4.50 125ml Glass, £7.50 250ml Glass, £20.00 Bottle

Aromas of lemon & gooseberries with a zesty finish.

12.Short Mile Bay Chardonnay – *South East Australia*

£5.10 125ml Glass, £7.90 250ml Glass, £22 Bottle

Unoaked, a tropical fruit flavoured wine with notes of spring blossom & honey.

13.Da Luca Pinot Grigio, Terre Siciliane – *Italy*

£5.20 125ml Glass, 8.10 250ml Glass, £24 Bottle

Aromas of white flowers, pink grapefruit & Cox's apple: the palate displays melon & guava.

14.Waipara Hills Sauvignon Blanc – *New Zealand*

£6.50 125ml Glass £9.50 250ml Glass, £28.00 Bottle

Generous & lifted, showing powerful aromas of nettle & snow pea: the palate bursts with fresh citrus, grapefruit & melon notes.

15.Picpoul de Pinet, Les Girelles, Jean-Luc Colombo – *France*

£30.00 Bottle

A rich, mouth-filling wine with notes of fresh flowers, melon & ripe summer stone fruit.

16.Shannon Semillon, Elgin Valley – *South Africa*

£33 Bottle

Show notes of ginger, lime zest & quinine: the palate is full & rounded and mineral.

17.Soellner Wogenrain Grüner Veltliner – *Austria*

£34 Bottle

Made from biodynamically produced fruit (making it organic as well) fantastically fresh with classic white pepper notes & aromatic flavours.

18.Bay of Fires Riesling, Tasmania – *Australia*

£36 Bottle

Flaunts a bouquet of fresh lime coupled with subtle hints of musk: the juicy, vibrant palate shows luscious citrus and a crisp mineral acidity.

19.Sancerre, Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot – *France*

£40.00 Bottle

Stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish, from one of the finest and most dynamic producers.

20.Chablis Cellier de la Sablière, Louis Jadot – *France*

£45.00 Bottle

A fuller style of Chablis, dry, but also with a well-rounded finish and subtle hints of toasty-vanilla oak flavours.

Rosé Wine

21. Los Romeros Merlot Rosé – *Chile*

£4.50 125ml £7.50 250ml & £20.00 Bottle

Raspberry & Strawberry aromas with blackcurrant pleasant flavours make this a soft easy drinking wine.

22. Côtes de Provence Rosé, – *France*

£29 Bottle (BIN END LIMITED STOCK)

Bright & perfumed, the wine offers up peach, candied orange & hints of red summer berries.

23. Sancerre Rosé, Le Rabault, Joseph Mellot – *France*

£37.50 Bottle

Pinot Noir exudes tantalising fragrances of the summer berries, richly ripe & delicately fresh.

24. Whispering Hills White Zinfandel – *USA*

£5.10 125ml £7.90 250ml & £22 Bottle

Fresh summer-fruit flavours and lively, acidity Medium-bodied to appeal to most palates, California's own Zinfandel.

Red Wine

25. Los Romeros Merlot – *Chile*

£4.50 125ml £7.50 250ml & £20.00 Bottle

Soft, warm and smooth red with lots of blackcurrant & plum fruits & a dash of spice.

26. Short Mile Bay Shiraz – *Australia*

£5.10 125ml £7.90 250ml & £22 Bottle

Rich berry fruit on the palate & a pinch of pepper spice so typical of Shiraz.

27. Between Thorns Cabernet Sauvignon

£5.10 125ml £7.90 250ml & £22 Bottle

Soft, ripe blackberry & raspberry flavours with a pinch of spice.

28. Durbanville Hills Pinotage, Durbanville – *South Africa*

£26.00 Bottle

A rich fruity character fills the mouth, backed by silky tannins, raspberry & red cherry flavours.

29. Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Corral – *Spain*

£28.00 Bottle

Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with cherries & sumptuous layered with a creamy barrique character.

30. Atamisque Serbal Malbec, Tupungato – *Argentina*

£32 Bottle

Aromas of red fruit & violet: wild raspberry & strawberry with splashes of plum & damson on the palate.

31. Primus Cabernet Sauvignon, Maipo Valley – *Chile*

£25 Bottle BIN END (Limited Stock)

Generously flavoured with cherry, raspberry & blueberry fruit, backed by a silky textured finish.

32. Vidal Reserve Pinot Noir, Marlborough – *New Zealand*

£37.00 Bottle

Raspberry sweetness showing through a youthful character, yet more structure & complexity developing from barrique-ageing.

33. Château de Bardes, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru – *France*

£38.00

The wine has rich, fruit aromas: juicy, sweet tannins backed by soft touches of vanilla-toastiness from time spent in oak.

34. The Federalist 1776 Zinfandel, Lodi – *USA*

£40.00

Plum & cherry dominate, backed up by cinnamon spice: full-bodied with long smooth finish
